Spark Central is looking for a Station Associate to work during Spokane Public Schools' Summer break to support our staff in operating our Creative Station and drop-in programming. This position is managed by our Program Director and works with key volunteers to ensure that our Creative Station provides much-needed technology, resource and enrichment programming access to West Central families.

DESCRIPTION

The Station Associate is someone who has a passion for youth service, community building and creativity. They are eager to share their love of art, writing, coding, robotics or other creative field(s) with Spark Central patrons and are comfortable working with a variety of age groups. Experience with youth in a school or after school setting is strongly preferred.

The Station Associate also assists our staff with maintaining the safety, organization and accessibility of Spark Central. Although direct service to youth and families is the position's primary responsibility, they may assist with a number of ongoing tasks during the term of their service, including cleaning, library maintenance, outreach and communication with Spark Central members, and troubleshooting of technology issues. Experience in all of these fields is not required, and applicants may expect for these secondary duties to be tailored to their areas of strength.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Act as Spark Central's representative as you welcome families, youth, and adult visitors to our public station open hours.

- 2. Learn Spark Central's mission, program offerings and current operating procedures in order to explain them to visitors and answer questions about our organization.
- 3. Learn the names of regulars and ask how they are doing when they come in. Engage any unattended youth (ages 10 and up) in creative activities we provide, maintaining social distancing.
- 4. Extend support to visitors of all races, ethnicities, sexual orientations/identities, differing ability levels, and backgrounds using an anti-racist and trauma-informed approach.
- 5. Offer free membership to each new visitor and assist with the sign-up process.
- 6. Learn our Koha sofware and use it to check-out, check-in, and assist staff with management of our book, technology, and creative kit collection.
- 7. Collaborate with staff to trouble-shoot station technology issues and to maintain an adequate inventory of creative supplies for public use.
- 8. Work with lead volunteers for Spark Central's family-focused and youth-focused drop-in programs to support their administration and provide a high-quality, enriching experience for patrons attending these programs.
- 9. Work with the Program Director to plan and run a drop-in club for upper elementary and middle-school aged youth focused on an area of creative activity such as visual arts, tinkering or writing.
- 10. Get to know our station volunteers and make them feel welcome, engaging them to support you in your other tasks as needed.
- 11. Be accountable and dependable, communicating regularly with staff about progress and

- Passion for creative expression and/or STEAM education, DEIJ, and service to low-income communities
- Passion for and experience working with elementary and/or middle-school-aged youth, especially youth who have experienced trauma
- Responsible self-starter; task and detail-oriented
- Comfort with both Mac and PC interfaces
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Above-average—bordering on exceptional—organizational skills
- Has patience, stamina, and flexibility to work in a busy, active environment with interruptions
- Reliable—good at watching the time
